MLS COVID POLICY as of JULY 1, 2021

Major League Softball, Inc. is following the California Public Department of Health and CDC Guidelines for all of our City Sponsored Adult Softball Programs.

For everyone's health and safety, we continue to ask our players and spectators to stay home if they are exhibiting signs of COVID-19.

It's important to note that the California Department of Public Health and Center for Disease and Control Prevention still require face coverings for all <u>unvaccinated</u> individuals ... and is <u>optional</u> for fully vaccinated individuals. We ask that all MLS Officials, players and spectators respect the choices of others when it comes to mask wearing.

We also encourage everyone to wash their hands with soap and water to help decrease the spread of germs.

If players and/or spectators come to any park facility without a mask, we must assume they are fully vaccinated – we cannot ask anyone if they are vaccinated, and we cannot ask them to put on a mask. If players and/or spectators are exhibiting COVID symptoms, we can still ask that they leave for the health and wellness of everyone in at the park.
