SAN DIMAS FIELD RULES

NORTH WEST FIELD:

RF: Tennis Court Fence: Over - HR

RF: Hits fence a ground rule double - OF needs to raise hands if the ball reaches the sidewalk

RF: Be aware, right at the corner of the tennis courts there is a sidewalk. If the ball comes in contact with sidewalk, it is a ground rule double - - OF needs to raise hands if the ball reaches the sidewalk

- * From corner of tennis courts to green box in LF open
- * Light Posts live/in play
- * Scoreboard is OUT OF PLAY territory
- **<u>LF:</u>** Green Box everything to the **<u>RIGHT</u>** is in play trees are live
- LF: Green Box everything to the LEFT is ground rule double
- LF: Building hit the building ground rule double
- LF: Hit the roof (blue) of the building HR
- <u>LF:</u> Hit the tree in front of the building and comes back down (in the leaves), ground rule double. If it goes through the tree and hits the roof, it's an HR.

ANYTIME A BATTED BALL HITS OR ROLLS INTO THE SIDEWALK AREAS LISTED ABOVE THE OUTFIELDER MUST RAISE THEIR ARMS STRAIGHT UP TO INDICATE TO THE UMPIRE THE BALL IS NOW IN "OUT OF PLAY" TERRITORY.

SOUTH WEST FIELD:

LF: Tennis Court Fence: Over - HR

LF: Hits fence a ground rule double - OF needs to raise hands if the ball reaches the sidewalk

LF: Into trees - ground rule double

RF: Over fence - HR (unlimited, no 1 up rule)

RF: Hits tree or GREEN BOX behind the fence and falls back into play OR lands over the fence – HR.

RF: LEFT of the RF fence is live UNLESS it hits the sidewalk - OF needs to raise hands if the ball reaches the sidewalk and it will be declared a ground rule double

RF: Down the foul line, if the ball is fair but rolls past the fence in the RF corner, ground rule double due to the sidewalk.
